A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY TO APPROVE THE PROPERTY TAX LEVY AND AUTHORIZE SUBMISSION TO THE COUNTY QUORUM COURT

WHEREAS, the City of Prairie Grove must determine the extent of the property tax levy for delivery to the Washington County Quorum Court; and

Section 3. The Clerk, should be, and is hereby, directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Washington County Clerk for delivery to the Washington County Quorum Court to assist in its deliberations at its November 2022 meeting.
