**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has revised Policy 03-001 regarding overtime; and


**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the City Council to be the body to approve all policy decisions on the behalf of the City.



**WHEREAS**, the City obtained pricing from two different suppliers; both of whom use the multi-governmental purchasing program Sourcewell; and


**WHEREAS**, the best and lowest prices are those from Miracle Recreation Equipment for a total price of \$116,712.00.

**WHEREAS**, such an investment will require the Council to adopt an Investment Policy; and


**WHEREAS**, the City had developed the attached investment policy for such investment.

RESOLUTION 2022-26

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY TO APPROVE THE PROPERTY TAX LEVY AND  
AUTHORIZE SUBMISSION TO THE COUNTY QUORUM COURT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Prairie Grove must determine the extent of the property tax  
levy for delivery to the Washington County Quorum Court; and

**WHEREAS**, the property tax is an important, fair and reasonable source of general  
revenue for the ongoing operation of the municipal government; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the people of the City of Prairie Grove that the  
levy be extended;


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF PRAIRIE GROVE, ARKANSAS THAT:**

Section 1. The property tax levy shall be and is recommended to the Quorum Court at:  
General Fund: Five mills (5).  
Police Department: (voluntary) One mill (1).  
Fire Department: (voluntary) One-half mill (0.5).

Section 2. Notwithstanding the language set forth in Section One, nothing contained  
therein shall preclude Washington County taxing and assessing administrators to bring the City's  
levy in compliance with any constitutional or statutory requirement.

Section 3. The Clerk, should be, and is hereby, directed to forward a copy of this  
resolution to the Washington County Clerk for delivery to the Washington County Quorum  
Court to assist in its deliberations at its November 2022 meeting.
