Prairie Grove Police Department Job Description – Police Officer

This is general police work in protecting life and property and enforcing laws and regulations. The patrol officer makes out daily reports of incidents and accidents; has continuous contact with the public requiring tact and diplomacy, makes decisions requiring mature judgment, has no supervisory responsibilities.

Work to be performed:

- 1. Patrols the city of Prairie Grove to prevent crime and enforce criminal and traffic laws.
- 2. Respond to radio dispatchers and answer calls and complaints from the public.
- 3. Direct and control the flow of traffic.
- 4. Educate the public on safety and law observance.
- 5. Follow the Community Policing Philosophy.
- 6. Assist in the investigation of accidents, felonies and misdemeanors.
- 7. Complete all paperwork according to prescribed procedures.
- 8. Perform other work as required to carry out the overall police protection of the City of Prairie Grove.

Minimum Requirements:

- 1. Must be a citizen of the United States.
- 2. High school graduate or equivalent
- 3. Ability to comprehend written material & write the English language.
- 4. Successful completion of Arkansas Law Enforcement Training Academy (after being hired).
- 5. Ability and willingness to be on call for twenty-four (24) hours a day.
- 6. Ability to operate standard office equipment and prepare records.
- 7. Must have valid driver's license.
- 8. Must pass standard medical and vision examinations.
- 9. Must pass psychological evaluation.
- 10. Must pass drug screen.
- 11. Must be able to qualify with firearm (after being hired).
