# AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SICK LEAVE FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE GROVE, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section One: <u>Title.</u> This Ordinance shall be known as the 2022 Fire Department Sick Leave Ordinance.

<u>Section Two:</u> <u>Section 2.28.06 Created.</u> From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, a new Section 2.28.06 of the Prairie Grove Municipal Code is hereby created pursuant to A.C.A. §14-53-108 to read as follows:

#### 2.28.06. Sick Leave.

Pursuant to §14-53-108, the City Council hereby establishes sick leave accrual for Fire Department employees as follows:

- A. 8-hour employees shall accrue 3.10 hours per pay period, beginning on the date of hire.
- B. 24-hour employees shall accrue 9.23 hours per pay period, beginning on the date of hire.
- C. The maximum accrued sick leave for any employee is 1,440 hours.

<u>Section Three:</u> <u>Ratification.</u> All sick leave previously accrued prior to the date of this ordinance is hereby ratified.

Section Four: Effective Date. This Ordinance, not being of a general and permanent nature, is effective immediately upon passage pursuant to A.C.A. §14-55-203(c)(2).

Section Five: Repealing Clause. Ordinances or parts thereof in force at the time that this ordinance shall take effect that are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section Six:</u> <u>Saving Clause.</u> Nothing herein shall be deemed to affect any rights or obligations existing at the time of the passage of this ordinance.

Section Seven: Severability Clause. # AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SICK LEAVE FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE GROVE, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section One: Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the 2022 Police Department Sick Leave Ordinance.

<u>Section Two:</u> <u>Section 2.32.12 Created.</u> From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, a new Section 2.32.12 of the Prairie Grove Municipal Code is hereby created pursuant to A.C.A. §14-52-107 to read as follows:

#### **2.32.12.** Sick Leave.

Pursuant to §14-52-107, the City Council hereby establishes sick leave accrual for Police Department employees as follows:

- A. Employees shall accrue 6.15 hours per pay period, beginning on the date of hire.
- B. The maximum accrued sick leave for any employee is 160 hours.

Section Three: Ratification. All sick leave previously accrued prior to the date of this ordinance is hereby ratified.

Section Four: Effective Date. This Ordinance, not being of a general and permanent nature, is effective immediately upon passage pursuant to A.C.A. §14-55-203(c)(2).

Section Five: Repealing Clause. Ordinances or parts thereof in force at the time that this ordinance shall take effect that are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section Six: Saving Clause. Nothing herein shall be deemed to affect any rights or obligations existing at the time of the passage of this ordinance.

Section Seven: Severability Clause. In the event any portion of this ordinance is declared inoperative or invalid as a result of a statute or judicial decision, then only that portion expressly so declared to be inoperative or invalid shall be affected thereby and all other provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.
